

MANUAL INSTALLATION OF VIRTUALBOX GUEST ADDITIONS

SCOPE

This article discusses manual installation of VirtualBox Guest Additions.

CURRENT VERSION

ShadowSnap 3.0 comes bundled with VirtualBox Guest Additions 4.0.18, the last version of VirtualBox Guest Additions that can be installed on a machine not already within VirtualBox.

VirtualBox Guest Additions aids the virtualization process by installing drivers for keyboard, mouse, and network connectivity to function better within the VirtualBox environment.

Without the installation of this software package, functionality of virtual machines will be degraded.

INSTALLATION

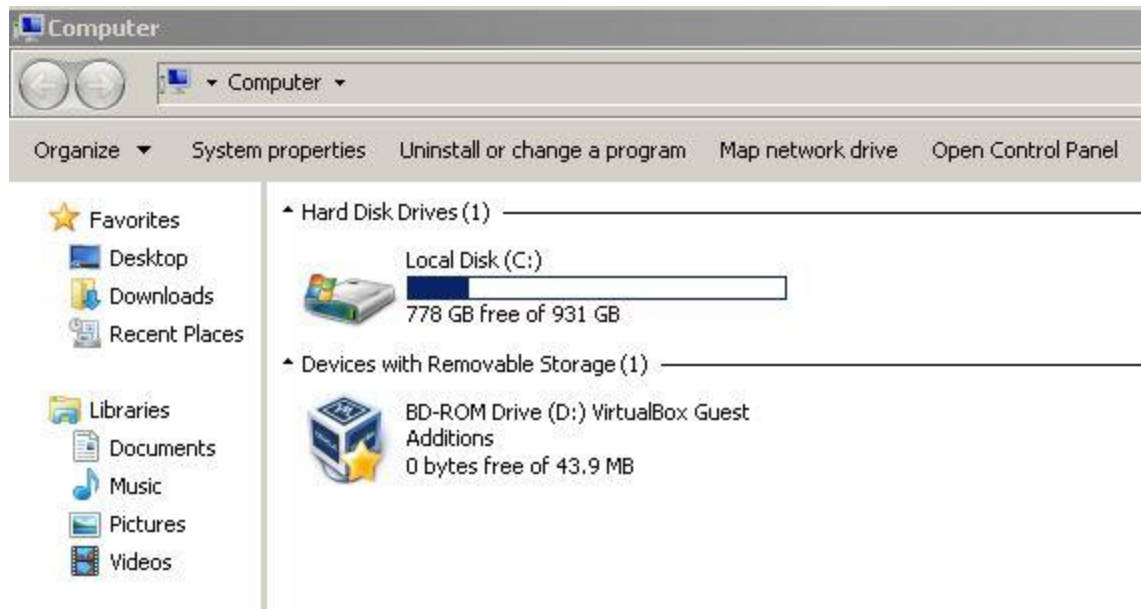
When performing a manual installation of VirtualBox Guest Additions, you will need a program that allows you to mount ISOs to virtual CD drives.

Example programs follow (QBR Technical Support does not officially endorse one program over the other)

Once you have the program installed, the ISO can be mounted and then selected:

From this screen you can proceed forward with the installation of the software.

You may be prompted for the installation of system drivers. This is normal as the network drivers and pointing devices that VirtualBox uses are installed onto the device.

- This is similar to VMware Tools for VMWare or additions for Hyper V Hosts to allow for control of the machines.

Once this is complete, you will be prompted for a restart which can be done at your convenience.

This will complete the VirtualBox Guest Additions install. You'll see it in the control panel under Add/Remove Programs
